PRODUCTION PROCESS
Selected grapes from old vines grown in the highest areas of the Rioja Alavesa, near to the Sierra Cantabria Mountains. Traditional production methods including gentle winemaking processes to maximise fruit expression. Temperature-controlled fermentation.

AGEING
26 months in French oak barrels. The wine remains in the bottle for at least 36 months.

Large and feathered game, all types of meat and mature cheeses.

VISUAL

Deep cherry red.



NOSE

Subtle and elegant, displaying distinct yet well combined layers of aromas. Aromas of red fruit, raisins and forest forests are intertwined with notes of spice, such as mint, cinnamon and cedar.



PALATE

It has a soft, silky texture, enveloping the palate with delicious flavours and fine, well-balanced acidity giving lively freshness.
